

Volunteer FAQ's



How old do I have to be?

We ask the volunteers be at least 15 years old to work as a volunteer. A parent or guardian must sign your paperwork stating that you are allowed to volunteer with NOH.

Does NOH provide training?

Yes! We provide two new season training engagements and one mid-season training to get new volunteers up to speed. Specialized training for concessions and guiding tours is also offered at least once a season.

What's the time commitment?

You decide that! Our volunteer program is a work at your own pace program. We request that you work at least 2 events per month, but it's not a deal-breaker.

Do I need theater experience?

Absolutely not! While previous theater or arts volunteer experience is always a plus, it's certainly not a requirement. We just need you, and your positive attitude in order to be successful!

What can I expect to encounter while volunteering?

In addition to becoming the face of the Opera House, you'll meet wonderful new friends and see some pretty great performances and events. Our volunteers take ownership of their roles and are truly the biggest ambassador for the Newberry Opera House.

What are the perks?

You'll get to see the show/events you work for free, but you'll also get discounts on tickets purchased and a chance to earn free tickets based on events worked.
